In May 2008, the Association of Hispanic Alumni of the University of Florida held the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Gator Guayabera Guateque. Held in Coral Gables, this celebration's purpose was to raise funds to benefit the Institute of Hispanic-Latino Cultures and continue the Association of Hispanic Alumni Scholarship Program. Due to the generosity of alumni, students and friends, the Association bestowed a \$45,000 donation at the Gator Guayabera Encore in October 2008, of which \$12,400 has been designated towards scholarship awards for UF students.

**Description:** The Rafael & Fe Angulo Awards are merit based scholarships given to recognize seven University of Florida undergraduate students who have excelled in leadership, service and/or academic scholarship and who have made a positive impact on the Hispanic-Latino community. One undergraduate scholarship in the amount of \$750 will be awarded; and seven undergraduate scholarships will be awarded, each in the amount of \$500.

#### Eligibility:

- ◆ Must be a currently enrolled University of Florida student who will be a degree seeking, undergraduate student enrolled at the University of Florida in Fall 2009. In addition, students must be enrolled full-time (12 credit hours) and in good academic standing in Fall 2009.

- ◆ Resume
- ◆ A current University of Florida official transcript (no photocopies accepted) which documents a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.7 on a 4.0 scale on all credits.
