In May 2008, the Association of Hispanic Alumni of the University of Florida held the 5th Annual Gator Guayabera Guateque. Held in Coral Gables, this celebration's purpose was to raise funds to benefit the Institute of Hispanic-Latino Cultures and continue the Association of Hispanic Alumni Scholarship Program. Due to the generosity of alumni, students and friends, the Association bestowed a \$45,000 donation at the Gator Guayabera Encore in October 2009, of which \$12,400 has been designated towards scholarship awards for UF students.

Description: The Juan and Elvia Roig's Scholarship will be awarded in 2008. It honors Mr. Juan Roig (in memoriam) and Mrs. Elvia Roig. The award is given in order to recognize a University of Florida undergraduate who through his or her community service has become a role model to the Hispanic-Latino community. One award will be given in the amount of \$400.

Eligibility:

- ◆ Must be a currently enrolled University of Florida student who will be a degree seeking, undergraduate student enrolled at the University of Florida in Fall 2009. In addition, students must be enrolled full-time (12 credit hours) and in good academic standing in Fall 2009.

Required materials:

- ◆ Resume
- ◆ A current University of Florida official transcript (no photocopies accepted) in a sealed envelope which documents a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale on all credits.
